Sizing Chart

Children grow quickly and depending on their age, their shoe size also increases on average by 2-3 sizes each year. Check the length of your child's foot every 2-3 months. Children generally do not complain of discomfort when their shoes are too short or too tight.

We like to fit shoes with an extra 9-15mm or "thumb's width" between the longest toe and the end of the shoe. This allows for growing room to ensure your child gets the most out of their shoes.

Different brands do run differently in sizing. Let us know what your child measured and we will suggest the right size in the brand you are looking at.

Instructions

1. Place child's heel on the clown's smile, making sure that the child's weight is on both feet. Trace all the way around each foot on the chart.
2. Read the first line past the longest toe.
3. Make sure to measure both feet, use the larger size when ordering.
4. Our expert fitters will help you to determine which size your child needs if you fax the chart to us at 612-823-0543.
